Curriculum Overview 2023

Religious Education

This term in Religious Education lessons, students will be exploring how God's family learn and pray together. Your child will identify what families teach each other and the ways that they show love and respect to one another.

Mathematics

In Mathematics this term we will be focusing on the following:

- Number and place value to three digits
- Shapes and 2D shapes
- Fractions and decimals
- Addition and counting strategies
- Counting backwards and subtraction
- Months and seasons
- Units of measurement

Languages: Auslan

We will continue to learn high-frequency, high interest signs relating to our lives. Signs for food and feelings will be taught along with ongoing revision of known vocabulary and the Auslan alphabet. In Auslan if there is not a sign for a word it is finger spelt, hence the continuous emphasis on finger spelling revision in fun ways using games and hands on activities.

English

In Writing students will learn about the elements of a narrative text so they can create their own before moving onto creating their own persuasive text developing the use of adjectives, nouns and verbs. We follow the Diana Rigg Spelling and Reading Program, with daily guided reading sessions. The Heggerty Program supports the development of phonemic awareness and Oxford learning to support handwriting skills.

Digital Technology

This term in Digital Technologies students will be working both independently and as a group to design, create and evaluate the usefulness of different apps for presenting information. Students will explore the benefits and limitations of Pages, PicCollage Edu, Keynote, Chatterpix, and Draw and Tell.

Visual Arts

In Visual Art this term, children will be continuing their discovery of famous artists. They will be exploring paint, pastel and watercolour.

Science

In our Physical Sciences units this term, students will be experimenting to learn about light, sound and push and pull forces.

Music

Term Two involves Music Feste. Their item is Rainbow by Andrew Chinn. The students will be practicing their item which involves singing and percussion instruments. Students will develop performance skills such as singing and playing in correct time and technique. They will be involved with input on how their performance should look and sound like. It is also a time to practice good audience behaviour.

Health

This term our Health and Keeping Safe Child Protection focuses on relationships. We will explore relationships, create a relationship circle, explore how to deal with bullying and explore the concepts of power and trusted networks.

HASS

This term in HASS students will continue on from their learning in Term 1. They will investigate how the present is different from or similar to the past. They will learn to use sources, such as interviews, photographs and artefacts to gather information and communicate their understandings.

Physical Education

This term in Physical Education lessons, the children will be preparing for Cross Country by moving for an extended period of time. The children will also learn and apply various ball skills when playing a range of winter sports.

Homework

In Year 1 and 2 the children are required to engage in daily spelling and daily reading. New books are issued on a Monday and Wednesday. Library books will be issued on a Tuesday.
