Religious Education

This term in Religious Education students will be exploring the units of Prayer and Baptism.

- In Prayer, students will be exploring how people grow and change in many ways along with how prayer is a relationship with God.
- In Baptism, students will be examining how people can live their lives justly and show everyone the same love and goodness.

Health

This term in Health students will be looking at:

- Ways that individuals and groups adapt to different contexts and situations
- Reliable sources of information that inform health, safety and wellbeing
- Skills and strategies to establish and manage relationships over time
- Strategies that promote a safe, healthy lifestyle.

Mathematics

This term in Mathematics students will be exploring the following topics:

- Mental and written subtraction strategies
- Divisibility
- 3D objects
- Factors and multiples
- Comparing, ordering, adding and subtracting fractions
- Grid references
- Giving directions

History

This term in History students will be focusing on:

- The colonial life in Australia
- Significant people, groups, developments and events that shaped the colonies in Australia.
- We will also develop a timeline of events and significant developments across the colonies in Australia

Auslan

This term in Auslan, students will continue to learn high-frequency, high interest signs relating to our lives. Signs for food and feelings will be taught along with ongoing revision of known vocabulary and the Auslan alphabet. In Auslan if there is not a sign for a word it is finger spelt, hence the continuous emphasis on finger spelling revision in fun ways using games and hands on activities.

English

This term in English students will be learning how to write expositive and explanatory texts. Students will be focusing on editing their work, including simple, compound and complex sentences with higher order connectives, and embedding quotes.

Music

This term in Music is all about Music Feste. The students will be performing Pachelbel's Canon in D. Students will be learning and maintaining their own part at correct timing and technique when performing with their classmates. The students will be able to reflect on their practices and use it to work on their performances to engage an audience.

Science

This term in Science, students will be using inquiry skills to learn about Physical Sciences, developing the understanding that light from a source forms shadows and can be absorbed, reflected and refracted. They will then explore how electrical energy can be transferred and transformed in electrical circuits and can be generated from a range of sources.

Homework

- Spelling (daily in their homework book)
- Mathematics (completed by Friday each week)
- Reading (10-20 minutes daily out loud and signed off in their Diary)

Visual Arts

This term in Visual Arts, students will be continuing their discovery of famous artists. They will be exploring paint, pastel and watercolour.

Physical Education

This term in Physical Education, students will be preparing for Cross Country by moving for an extended period of time. Students will also learn and apply various ball skills when playing winter sports.

Digital Technologies

This term in Digital Technologies students will examine how whole numbers are used to represent all data in digital systems.
